
Technician Assistant (TA)

If you are interested in becoming a BACB-certified Behavior Technician (BT) and would like on the job training through that process, you could be a great fit for our center-based Technician Assistant role.

What is the difference between a Behavior Technician and a Technician Assistant?

Technician Assistant:

- Work in our center to receive supervision and training while working with clients
- Earn \$10 per hour
- Work as a floater who assists other team members or fills in for 1:1 client sessions

Behavior Technician working for POTP:

- Independently work 1:1 with clients in the home, school, or center setting
- Eligible to bill services to Medicaid and commercial insurance
- Earn between \$15-\$20 per hour for billable services
- Eligible for 401k benefits and employee rewards

Working as a TA as you become certified:

- Piece of the Puzzle will compensate you \$100 for the cost of your 40-hour RBT course.
- The course and competency assessment must be completed within 30 days of committing.
- While you are working on the course, you can train with certified ABA professionals in one of our Center locations.

While working as a TA, you'll do the following daily:

- Learn ABA basics while working hands on with our clients
- How to write session notes while in session
- How to collect ABC data and record in our data collection software
- How to practice ABA ethically and work as part of a team
- How to effectively read and implement protocols developed by a BCBA
- Learn our company specific systems and get to know your clients and teammates
- Lead group activities for clients
- Prepare craft activities and assist in maintaining center

Piece of the Puzzle will provide you with effective training experience and materials to prepare you for taking the BACB's RBT exam. Upon passing the RBT exam, the TA will be eligible for consideration to transition from TA to BT.
